Affidavits, to be produced to you, under the hand
or hands, of any one or more of Our Justices of
the Peace, of his being alive, and not otherwise
provided for by any place of Profit, or ^{any} other Employment
civil or Military under us, than by this his Half
Pay, until our further Order. And for so doing,
this, with the Acquittance of the said John Gunning
or of his Assign, together with the said certificates
or Affidavits from time to time shall be your
warrant and Discharge. Given at our
Court at St. James's This 28.th day of August
1799 in the Thirty Ninth year of our Reign.
