Whereas we have thought fit to
give Leave unto John Gunning Surgeon to our
Forces to make an Exchange of his Commission, with
the Half Pay of Alexander Grant a Reduced Surgeon
of our West India Staff, and to allow Half Pay unto
the said John Gunning in the room of the said
Alexander Grant. Our Will and Pleasure, therefore,
is, and we do hereby authorize and direct, that
out of such Monies as are in or shall come to
your hands for the use of the reduced Officers of
our Land Forces and Marines on Half Pay in
our Kingdom of Great Britain you pay unto
the said John Gunning the Sum of Five
Shillings a day for his Half Pay as a Reduced
Surgeon as aforesaid, to commence the 25th
day of April 1799 inclusive, and to be continued
and paid unto him by Quarterly payments or
otherwise, as the same shall grow due, and as
our other Reduced Officers on Half Pay, are, and
shall
