WE by the Grace of God King of Great Britain, France and Ireland Defender of
the Faith &c. To our Trusty and Wellbelov'd Arthur Holdsworth Junr. Gent. Greeting.
We do by these presents constitute and appoint you to be Fort Major of our Castles and
Block-Houses in our Town and Port of Dartmouth in our County of Devon, you are therefore
carefully and Diligently to discharge the Duty of Fort Major of our aforesaid Castles
and Block-Houses by doing and performing all and all manner of Things therunto
belonging, and you are to observe and follow such Orders and Directions from time
to time as you shall receive from our Governour thereof for the time being
or any other your Superior Officer according to the Rules and Discipline of
War. Given at our Court at Whitehall the Twentieth Fifth Day of December 1725. ⁴
in the Twelfth year of our Reign.
