Brother with all manner of Wages, Fees, Allowances, Profits, Rewards,  
Commodities and Advantages whatsoever unto the same year by  
belonging and appertaining during the natural Life of the said  
John Cam at such times as the same are used to be paid and  
allowed in as large and ample manner as any of the Poor Brothers  
presently have and enjoy or of right ought to have and enjoy according  
to the Foundation of the said Hospital And these Our Letters shall  
be your sufficient Warrant and Discharge in that behalf Given  
at St. James's the 22. day of February 1808 in the forty eighth  
Year of the Reign of Our Dearest Lord and Husband.
