 carefully and dilligently to discharge the Duty of Lieutenant by exercising and well Disciplining
 both the Inferiour Officers and Soldiers of that Company, And We hereby Command them to
 Obey you as their Lieutenant and you to observe and follow such Orders and Directions from time
 to time as you shall recieve from your Colonel, Captain, or any other your Superior Officer according
 to the Rules and Discipline of War, In pursuance of the Trust hereby reposed in you Given at
 Our Court at S^t James's the Tenth day of March 1701 In the First Year
 of Our Reign.
