What caused your Deafness? Not anything special so far as I know - There may have been a certain amount of innate predisposition, increasing with years

Have you noises in the head or ears? In ears, not head

Describe them Something like water splashing or gushing, & a rumbling under-current

Are the noises constant or intermittent? Constant - but very often they don't catch my attention

Was deafness sudden or gradual? Gradual

Do you suffer from nasal or throat Catarrh? Not in any

Does your hearing vary with changes of the weather? I don't think so

Can you hear a watch tick more distinctly if pressed against the bones of the forehead? No

Can you hear better in a noise, as when travelling by Train or

Omnibus? I sh^d say not

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Is there any ear discharge? No

Can you hear a watch tick? I hear it, but rather faintly, when touching the ear

How far from right ear? —

How long have you been deaf? I sh^d say that a certain deterioration of hearing began towards 1890 - The deterioration has since then much increased, without violent shocks

Is your general health good or bad? Good

Do you suffer from Indigestion No Constipation? Only occasionally

Sluggish Liver Occasionally

Is your ear-wax dry, hard, or excessive Might be called tending to dry - not in the least excessive

What remedies have you used? I might say None - I once (c. 1901) consulted an Aurist - He removed some hard wax from one ear, & my hearing then improved to an appreciable extent, but not with permanent effect
With what effect? See above

Do you suffer from Gout? — Rheumatism? From gout at times - not severely - Also from rheumatism (or sciatica) at times, not very severely - & muscular rheumatism (moderate) in right arm & chest
Have you used much Quinine or Mercury next to no quinine - no mercury

Have you ever had a severe blow on the head, or a fall? No

Do you suffer from severe headaches? No - peculiarly free from them

Are your teeth in good condition? I have never suffered greatly with my teeth - By this time several have been extracted: the remainder of late years give me no trouble
