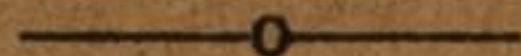
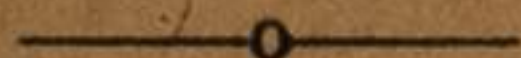

Custer's last stand was not a filling station.



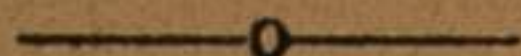
Noah was the first big game hunter.

Birds and United States congressmen scatter seeds for nothing.



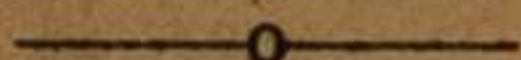
The Puritans held the first Thanksgiving because they were thankful that they crossed the Atlantic "first class."
