

Dear Policy-holder:

Pursuant to the instructions of the Directors of your Company, you will find enclosed notice of a special meeting of the policy-holders of The Great State Life Insurance Company, to be held on August 4th, 1924. The purpose of this meeting is to enable the policy-holders of The Great State Life Insurance Company to vote and act upon a proposed contract of re-insurance between your Company and the Royal Union Life Insurance Company of Des Moines, Iowa.
