Dear Janet:

In making my income tax report for this year, it is necessary for me to report certain gifts that I have made in past years.

On September 10th, 1938, I gave you house and lot at 1709 Alabama Street, cost price to me \$3,750.

At the time of the purchase of your home on September 3, 1938, I made you an advance of \$5,000. Under date of December 5, 1938, I made a notation showing that I had given you \$1,250 of the amount and in December, 1939, I made you a present of \$3,750 to wipe out the balance on the \$5,000 advanced to you in 1938.

On the gift in 1941 of the property at 706 Mass. Street, valuation \$5,000, we made you a gift of \$4,000, and took your promissory note for the difference, \$1,000.

Mr. Asher, who is assisting us in this matter, will write you sending papers to be filled out as a donee which you will please fill out and return to him.

We hope to be seeing you the first of the week if the roads are passable.
