Your physical examination, as I told you the other day, was entirely normal with the exception of a blood pressure of 180/110. The findings on urine analysis were completely within normal limits. The only suggestion I might offer upon reviewing your examination and laboratory work is that your blood pressure be rechecked at intervals of every few weeks for the next few months.
