They tried it at the home, but he said they hurt, and as his whiskers are tough, I know that they must have, but a barber knows how to handle it.

I found his book and have it. All the stamps are in place and it is paid up to December 1st, but believe I will drop over about the middle of November and pay up for another month to keep ahead.

He was brighter both days, and asked after Gertrude. Also commented about the weather but said he could not go out yet.
