Dear Collie,

I have your note of the 19th and am leaving tonight on #5 for Houston arriving there Monday morning. I expect to leave there Tuesday night if everything goes regularly which would put me into Lawrence on the night of the 25th, however, I shall wire you from Houston. I will have to leave Lawrence either on the streamliner or a bus as I have an appointment in Kansas City which must be kept and from there will return to Chicago arriving here on the morning of the 27th. 26th

We have had considerable water and the line was seriously effected but #5 went over yesterday for the first time in several days, the bridge having been repaired. We have had to detour not only over the Union Pacific but the Rock Island and Frisco Lines but we carried through very nicely considering all the trouble.
