

## OPEN SEASONS

BLACK BASS—July 1st to October 15th, except—

- (a) River St. Clair, Lake St. Clair, Detroit River, Lake Erie and Niagara River from Lake Erie to Niagara Falls: June 25th to December 15th.

MASKINONGE—July 1st to October 1st, except—

- (a) River St. Clair, Lake St. Clair, Detroit River, Lake Erie and Niagara River from Lake Erie to Niagara Falls: June 25th to December 15th.

- (b) North and west of and including the French and Mattawa Rivers and Lake Nipissing: June 20th to October 1st.

SPECKLED TROUT, BROWN TROUT, RAINBOW TROUT, KAM-  
LOOPS TROUT and AURORA TROUT — From May 1st to  
September 15th.

LAKE TROUT—No close season in Great Lakes, Georgian Bay, North  
Channel, Bay of Quinte and River St. Lawrence.

INLAND WATERS—

- (a) South of and excluding the French and Mattawa Rivers and Lake Nipissing, from November 6th to October 5th, next following.

- (b) North and west of and including the French and Mattawa Rivers and Lake Nipissing: No close season when taken by angling.

YELLOW PICKEREL—No close season in Great Lakes, (excepting in  
Bay of Quinte) Georgian Bay, North Channel and their inter-  
vening international connecting waters and River St. Lawrence.

INLAND WATERS—

- (a) South of and including the French and Mattawa Rivers and Lake Nipissing, from May 15th to December 31st, (except Bay of Quinte May 15th to March 31st, next following).

- (b) North and west of and excluding the French and Mattawa Rivers and Lake Nipissing, May 15th to April 14th, next following.

PIKE—No close season in Great Lakes, Georgian Bay, North Channel  
and their intervening international connecting waters and River  
St. Lawrence.

INLAND WATERS—

- (a) South of and including the French and Mattawa Rivers and Lake Nipissing, May 15th to March 31st, next following.

- (b) North and west of and excluding the French and Mattawa Rivers and Lake Nipissing, no close season if taken by angling.  
(NOTE—All dates herein mentioned are inclusive)

## BAG LIMITS

BLACK BASS—6 per day, minimum length 10 inches.

MASKINONGE—2 per day, 14 per season, minimum length 30 inches.

YELLOW PICKEREL—6 per day, minimum length 13 inches.

PIKE—6 per day, regardless of length.

PERCH—25 per day, (except Lake Mindemoya, 10 per day).

LAKE TROUT—5 per day.

RAINBOW TROUT, BROWN TROUT, AURORA TROUT, KAM-  
LOOPS TROUT—5 per day, minimum length 7 inches.

SPECKLED TROUT—20 per day, or 10 pounds weight, (except  
Norfolk County, 10 per day, or 5 pounds weight), minimum  
length 7 inches.

CRAPPIES—20 per day.
