We have broken up joint after joint through our efforts, and Lawrence is largely the law-abiding and outstanding city that it is because of the leadership of the Journal-World. You owe us an apology for the intended insults contained in your letter, but we shall not swerve from our policy of temperance and law-enforcement, and such space as we shall continue to give in support of the continuance of the prohibitory law and against its repeal, willmbe without the acceptance of payment for space on the part of yourself, or of others.
