

Article 6. OFFICERS—The officers of this Association shall be President (preferably a blind person), Vice-President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, Financial Secretary, Treasurer, Secretary-Treasurer of Revolving Fund, and Board of Directors.

Article 7. It shall be the policy of this Association to solicit and accept gifts, bequests, and appropriations of money and property (personal and real) for the prosecution and maintenance of its objects.

## BY-LAWS

Article 1. All persons interested in promoting the welfare of the blind shall be eligible to membership in this Association. The membership shall consist of four classes:

1. Active members who shall pay the annual dues of one dollar.

2. Sustaining members who shall pay the annual dues of five dollars.

3. Life memberships and memorial memberships which shall be granted on payment of \$100.00.

4. Organization Memberships: Organizations may become sustaining or life members of the Association by payment of the dues required for such memberships and shall be entitled to one vote for each ten members or major fraction thereof.

Article 2. DUTIES OF OFFICERS—The President shall preside at all meetings, shall appoint the committees necessary for carrying on the work of the Association, and shall be ex-officio member of all committees.

The Vice-President shall perform the duties usual to that office and shall be ex-officio chairman of the program committee.

The Recording Secretary shall keep the minutes of all meetings of the Association and of the Board of Directors, and shall have charge of and be the custodian of all property, documents and papers belonging to the association, and shall keep a classified list of all members.
