Dear Mr. Howard:

I am informed that a dripping faucet at the Wakarusa town hall is, partly at least, responsible for draining water out on to the five acre tract which joins the Wakarusa town hall property on the south. This property belonged to me, but several years ago the title passed to my daughter, Mrs. H. F. Johnson, of Wymore, Nebraska.

We have continued to look after the property as well as we can. I have no doubt that this leak is a very simple matter and may be quite easily corrected.

In my opinion the day is coming when the present site of this town hall will become so valuable that you may wish to move the hall to a location further out.

I have now been a resident and tax payer of Wakarusa township for thirty-two years.
