We send you herewith our check for \$5 to
cover bill dated August 31.

The workman who looked after our refrigerator
left the refrigerator standing quite a way out in
the room and when we moved it back into position,
the vibration with its attending noise continued
as before. I found, however, that by placing a
little empty cardboard box about 3" x 3" x 5" in
beside the motor, it absorbed the vibration and very
largely stopped the noise.

I would be glad to have the motor properly
balanced which probably would require new springs,
however, the cabin is closed now and probably will
not be reopened until next June.
