My dear Brother -

You got your first snow two days before we got it here but ours is staying on and the wind is blowing very hard and it is fairly cold. But I have to go into Brainerd this afternoon anyway -

The election news is very gratifying here all excepting our 6<sup>th</sup> dist. Congressman. Don and I and a number of people, including C. Elmer Anderson, made a tour of about twelve little cities and on up as far as Walker the day before election and Don our dad and had to stay in bed all day election day but did not lose his vote as one of the judges brought his ticket over here to him. and when the returns came in from the East - Don got better and better and was up yesterday and today but I do not think he can stand driving on long trips. so do not know just how we can get away for two months this winter unless we go by train. We thanked you for inviting us to visit you over the end of N.M. - Neb. and it would have been a great pleasure to have seen all your children & grand children.
