Harry Gowdy died within the last ten years, and his brother, Lauren, who lives north of Hanston some six or eight miles, would undoubtedly give you the particulars.

Mr. Charles Ruff says that Harrison Gowdy was buried at Jetmore, and confirms the statement made by others that it had been the intention to embalm and ship the body but that it arrived at Jetmore in too bad shape to permit of such action.
