Enlisted August 1, 1861, for service in the Civil War, and was assigned to duty as a musician, Company C, 37th Infantry, for a period of three years. He was mustered into the service September 18, 1861, at Chicago, Illinois.

The remarks do not show the termination of this service.

The records further indicate that one Adolph Simons enlisted on February 10, 1864, and was assigned to duty as a Principal Musician, Non-Commission Staff, 37th Infantry; he was mustered out May 5, 1866, at Houston, Texas.

Description as of August 1, 1861: Age, 27 years; Height, 5 feet, 11 inches; Hair, light; Eyes, blue; Complexion, fair; Occupation, musician; Nativity, Monroe County, New York.
