

These Markers are to be placed only on the graves of Soldiers, Sailors or Patriots of the War of 1812.

The marker consists of the insignia of the Society surrounded by a circle containing the inscription, "In Honor of Service in the War of 1812." The marker is made of United States statuary bronze. The rod is galvanized iron bronzed. At the back is a projection to hold the flag, and the name of the soldier, sailor or patriot is placed on a small cast bronze plate, which is securely fastened to the marker. (See illustration above.)

Blank permits will be sent by the Chairman of Grave-Markers on application. These must be filled out with the information necessary to identify the grave and verify the service of the soldier, sailor or patriot, and returned with the price of same to the chairman, who will then sign the permit and authorize the Bronze Memorial Studios to ship the marker to the person designated to receive it.

The markers will be shipped by express (express charges collect.) The weight of the grave marker, when packed, is seven and one-half pounds.

Checks or money order drawn to the order of BRONZE MEMORIAL STUDIOS must accompany each order for a Grave Marker, and must be mailed to the National Chairman and NOT to the manufacturer.
