Edward Southworth married in 1613 Alice Carpenter, B. 1590. Southworth died in 1620. She came to America on the Ann in June, 1623, and she married Gov. Wm. Bradford in August, 1623. Governor Bradford was married first in England to Dorothy May, who was drowned Dec. 1, 1620, before the Mayflower landed.

He married Alice Carpenter-Southworth, and she was the mother of Major Wm. Bradford, son of Governor Wm. Bradford. She therefore was my grandmother ten generations back.
