

The Fifth, and last territorial legislature, met at Lecompton, January 7, 1861 but came to Lawrence on January 8th to reconvene. This session Adjourned on February 2, 1861. There is no mention made in the book referred to above where this session was held, but the enclosed tear sheet from the Kansas City Times says they were in session at the Hotel Eldridge when word arrived in Lawrence that Kansas had been admitted to statehood.
