Dear Mr. Simons:

The boundaries of the original Town of Lawrence are as follows: Beginning in what is now Fifth Street at a point $60\frac{1}{2}$ feet West of the East line of Louisiana Street, thence running North to the River, thence following the River in a southeasterly direction to a point between Pennsylvania and Delaware Streets, about 75 feet West of the West line of Delaware Street, thence South to a point 30 feet South of the North line of what is now Fifteenth Street, thence West to the Section line on or near the West line of Louisiana Street, thence North to a point about 150 feet North of what is now Ninth Street, thence West to a point 61 feet West of the East line of Alabama Street, thence North to a point $18\frac{1}{2}$ feet North of the North line of what is now Fifth Street, thence East to the place of beginning.
