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Arthur Graves Canfield:

Professor of French at K. U. Married Jeannette Platt Sayre, daughter of Dr. Lucius Elmer Sayre, Dean of School of Pharmacy. Graduated from Williams 1878, studied abroad. Came to K. U. Faculty 1883. They were the parents of Dorothy Canfield Fisher.

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(Brother Dr. A. W. Clark) Artist, born in 1868. Lawrence, Massachusetts.

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Farmer and stockman. Donor of Westminster Hall to K. U. Listed in records but may not have been a member of Sons and Daughters of New England.

Charles Livingston Edwards:

Civil war soldier, first school teacher in Lawrence. Daughter, Virginia.

James D. Faxon

Col. Henry Martyn Green:

Norwich, Connecticut. Ed Law. Record - State Senator - Lieut. Col. U. S. A. - Civil war. Minister. Trustee of Lane University at Lecompton. Nine children.

Gurdon Grovenor:

Lumber. (Carter's Station) Board of Education, City Council, Mayor three times. Stalwart member of First Baptist Church.

Col. H. S. Hall:

Lost right arm at "P" (perhaps Petersburg). Brevetted General for gallant services. Of New England ancestry. Father of Clarence S. Hall, well known newspaper man.

Franklin Haskell:

Born Vermont. Was a member of Dr. Robinson's Co. Arrived in Lawrence Sept. 16, 1854. Father of Capt. John Gideon and Dudley Chase. H. (Left Yale.) Shoe merchant, athlete, baseball, silver ball, mammoth bat, homerun. Died in Congress after securing Indian School.

W. E. Hazen and Mrs. Hazen:

Son Leonard at Tonganoxie.

The Learnard Family:

Col. Oscar E. Learnard married the beautiful daughter of Col. Shalor W. Eldridge. He came originally from Burlington, Vermont, and was one of the founders of Burlington, Kansas. Lived on tract of ground directly North of Haskell Stadium - house facing North on

23rd Street.

Col. Learnard was born in 1882 and came to Lawrence as early as '56. Was a soldier in the Civil War and served in Western, Missouri and probably in Southeastern Kansas, Arkansas and Oklahoma. Consolidated Tribune and Journal in middle Eighties and occupied the building now known as the Fairfax Hotel. Had three sons, Paul, Tracy and O. E. L., Jr. Was a prominent citizen, was interested in founding the 56ers - forerunner of the Douglas County Old Settlers Society and of the Sons and Daughters of New England. Was Tax Commissioner for the Memphis Railway and the job printing for the railway was done in Lawrence - until the Memphis Ry. became a part of the Frisco system.

Was very proud of his son Paul who was Business Manager for the paper. Paul married a Miss Burdick of Burlington. And they had one son who died when about 16 years old. Paul lost his health and died at an early age. Mrs. Paul Learnard was for many years, secretary of the Sons and Daughters of New England. Afterwards, she returned to her former home in Burlington .

Prof. F. H. Snow:

Then Chancellor of K. U. was the first Vice-President of our Society. A small man physically who rode a bicycle, and built several rental homes on West Sixth Street, between Tennessee and Ohio. Was a compromise selection as Chancellor, when James Caufield would doubtless have been so honored, had he not been a Free Trader in historically Republican Kansas.

Snow had popularized himself with Kansas farmers thru his study of Ch~~an~~ch bugs, which resulted in methods for fighting them.

He started the collection of insects in K. U. Museum. He served until failing health caused him to resign and after a year's supply by W. C. Spangler, Dr. Frank Strong became Chancellor and served with distinction for 18 years.

Mrs. A. A. Russ:

Was a member of the first Executive Committee and was the mother of Dr. W. W. Russ, Dentist.

Dr. F. D. Morse, Col. H. L. Moore and S. J. Churchill prepared the first by-laws. Dr. Morse was my family physician for several years. He was a thorough gentleman and a successful physician. Col. Moore has already been mentioned, and S. J. Churchill was, etc.

Mrs. Hazen, Mrs. R. D. Mason, Prof. A. H. Clark, John Ross, Mrs. Learnard and Mrs. H. L. Moore, were appointed a committee to superintend the dinner and Mrs. Paul Brooks and Mrs. J. G. Haskell were added to the number.

Mrs. Mason was the wife of R. D. Mason, a shoe dealer, who was prominent in the community at that time.

John P. Ross was an agent for the Union Pacific Railway and conducted his business from an office in the N. E. corner of the Eldridge. After his death his daughter Belle conducted the office for several years.

Other members have already been mentioned.

John Fiske in his "Beginnings of New England" goes back more than six centuries.

On the title page of his book appears the following quotation from Edward Johnson: "The Lord Christ intends to achieve greater matters by this little handful than the world is aware of."

Edward Johnson, born in Eng. in 1599 came to America in 1630 with Gov. Winthrop and helped organize the town of Woburn. He is remembered as a business man, a colonial official and as an historian. I consider Fiske's history to be an excellent and interesting book.

I bought my copy from the estate of Mrs. Paul Brooks.

It bears the name I. S. Blackwelder and the date 1899. I think Mrs. Blackwelder was a sister of Mrs. Brooks, whose maiden name was Boughton.

To discuss the beginnings of our Society on this celebration of its 50th Anniversary, it seems proper to recall the landing at Plymouth in 1620 and the settlement of Lawrence beginning in 1854.

My regard for my ancestors-
The Pilgrims- may be appropriately epitomized from the account of Christ's Sermon on the Mount as given in Matthew:

"Ye shall know them by their fruits." "Do men

gather grapes of thorns,
or figs from thistles?"

"A good tree cannot bring
forth evil fruit, neither
can a corrupt tree bring
forth good fruit - where-
fore by their fruit ye
shall know them."

No other settlement made by
man has done so much for
mankind. From it came the
right of freedom to worship
God, and a recognition of
the rights of man as an
individual.

To understand more clearly
why the natives and desc-
endants of New England
formed a society of The
Sons and Daughters of New

England here in Lawrence 50 years ago, we go back to the question of human slavery, which had its beginning in antiquity.

In the West Indies and in South America, the Indians were enslaved and were brutally treated - while New England was not entirely free from slavery, it was not long endured and it was in New England that antislavery sentiment developed until it became a bone of contention, between the North and the South.

To make a long story as short as possible:

On March 11, 1854, more than two months before the Kans.-Nebraska bill was passed, a meeting of antislavery people was held in Worcester, Mass. At that time, Eli Thayer planned the organization of The New England Emigrant Aid Society for the ultimate purpose of making Kansas a Free State.

Following a number of changes in the original plans, the first group of immigrants arrived in Lawrence on Aug. 1, 1854. This party of 29 men had Chas. H. Branscomb for its leader.

A second party of 67 persons arrived in Lawrence Sept. 11 1854, led by Dr. Chas. Robinson.

Dr. Robinson, born in 1818, must have been endowed with a roving disposition, for he first visited the site of Lawrence in 1849, when at the age of 31 he was headed for the gold fields of California. He was 36 when he led his party to Lawrence and in 1860 he became the first state governor of Kansas.

As Lawrence was settled by young people, the average age of the survivors in 1896 when our society was formed, was probably 67 to 70 years.

The secretarial records of our society show that on the evening of Dec. 20, 1896 about 50 loyal New

Englishers met in Journal






