

Col. Horace Ladd Moore:

Born 2/25/37 Mantua, Ohio. Father was born in Conn. Merchant Lawrence, Kansas. Banker Lawrence, Kansas. Was interested in stores Colorado and New Mexico from 1867 to 1882. Treas. Douglas County. Member 53rd Congress. Came to Kansas in 1858 - by rail to St. Louis, by boat to Leavenworth. Studied law office Christian and Lane. Served 2nd Kansas Infantry May 14, '61 to Feb. 18, '64. In 2nd St. Louis Cavalry Feb. 19, '64 to June 30, '65. In 18th Kansas Cavalry from 7/15/67 till 11/15/67. In 19th Kansas Cavalry for 6 months beginning 11/1/68. Private in 2nd Infantry, Lieut. D. Co., 2nd Cavalry, Lieut. Col. 4th Arkansas Cavalry, Major 18th Kansas Cavalry, Col. 19th Kansas Cavalry. Indian wars.

Jno G. HaskellFred E. StimpsonEdgar Henry Summerfield Bailey:

5'6". Metallurgist. Yale 1873, studied abroad, PhD. Ill. Wesleyan, 1883. Came to K. U. same year.

Paul R. Brooks:

First merchant in Lawrence. Member of First City Council, member Territorial Legislature '59, County Clerk '63 to '74, County Treasurer '82 to '86. Came to Lawrence in Sept. 1854. Occupied first house in Lawrence - as a store - this is now Lot 2 on Lawrence plat, and is now the North part of the Underwood Mill. Lived on Tennessee St. present site of Kappa Alpha Theta Sorority. Wife conducted a greenhouse. Was cashier at Watkins National Bank and was later employed at Lawrence National. Married Mary A. Boughton, Oct. 3, 1858.
