Dear Dolph,

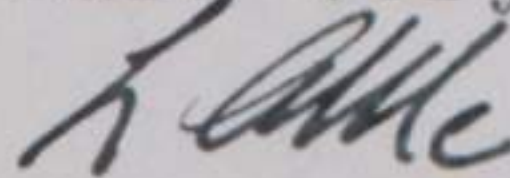
