Dear Dolph,

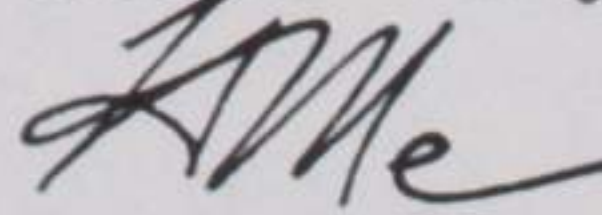
I have just received a check from the Treasurer of the United States for \$31.34 which is marked "Agricultural Conservation". This is on the Ellis County land and I inclose herewith a check for \$15.67 covering your half of this very generous disbursement from the Government.

I also have a statement from the County Treasurer showing all taxes there to be \$26.26. I am today mailing them a check for this amount and your share of the taxes will be \$13.13. This will leave a little profit over the amount we have received from the Government.

I wish you would also let me know the amount we paid per acre for the land in Texas and the same on the land in Oklahoma.
