 which M^r. Bambridge sayd to her from which
 severall Circumstances above she was Inclined to
 beleive the said Bambridge was a Roman Catholick
 and that the said person came to take his Confession
 which Opinion of the said Bambridge's being a
 Roman Catholick She then declared to severall of
 the State Prisoners then in Newgate And this Exam^t.
 observed the person whom she took to be a priest had
 his Teeth out before and ruddy Cheek and Complexion
 and full large black Eye brows and a very black Wig
 And this Examinant further saith that a considerable
 time after the said person had been with the said
 Bambridge John Campbelle came to this Examinant
 and asked her if she remembered any thing about a
 Romish priest coming to M^r. Bambridge And upon
 this Examinant telling the said Campbelle she
 remember'd a person's being twice with her Master
 Bambridge as above he desired her to describe him
 which she did by telling his Appearance & Dress as

above.
