 hand writing (which Copy is hereunto annexed)
 but upon the said Beatniff's, to this Examinant
 the said Note and delivering unto this Examinant
 the said Copy He this Examinant says he could
 not Swear to the contents thereof and that he
 was sorry he had signed it whereupon they
 insisted to have it back again as they have done
 several times since and of late Three or Four
 Times in a day And this Examinant further saith
 That after he was acquitted of his Accusation for
 Treason this Examinant was Ironed & Confined
 in One of the Cells for the space of 6 Weeks and at
 last was forced to give Two Guineas to Allen to
 gett them taken off. And that he this Examinant
 and another person now pay half a Crown a Week
 for a Dark Room not above eight or nine Foot
 square And this Examinant hath remained
 there under such close Confinement near Six
 Weeks And this Examinant further saith That
 it was about the latter End of April or beginning
 of May and (to the best of this Examinant's
 Remembrance) about fourteen or perhaps
 Twenty Days before the Parliament broke up
 that the said Bambridge told this Examinant
 that the said Lord Chief Justice was to make
 him a visit in Newgate And this Examinant
 further saith that this Day the said West came
 to this Examinant and asked him, how do you do.
