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Ann Johnson the wife of Roger Johnson
being Examined in the most solemn manner
this Twenty third Day of April 1730. saith That
She saw Mr. West severall times with her husband
in Newgate on the Masters Side and Beatniff
twice That she askd her Husband what they
came about he sayd about a paper w^{ch} Mr. Bambridge
was Endeavouring to prevail on her Husband to
Sign That it was about three Weeks or a Month
past She saw them first with her Husband And
that she was not actually in their conversation
but they had a Sneecker of punch and Drank
together but she saw West since that time alone
with her Husband And this Examinant's Husband
told her Mr. Bambridge had been there and got
him to Sign a paper, but before this the said
West and Beatniff came to her Husband & told
him Mr. Bambridge woud gett him to Sign a
paper And this Examinant saith That about
Three Days after the said West and Beatniff had
been with her Husband she went to her Husband
and was sitting upon his Bedside when the said
West alone came up into the Chamber to her Husband
and sayd Mr. Johnson are you not up yet, Mr.

Bambridge.
