Did you visit Bambridge in Newgate? Yes.
Give the Committee an Account of any particular
time that you was with him. I never made any
Memorandum as Bambridge had a House in
my parish and lived there, I thought fitt to pay
a Visit to him. Was you there more than Once?
I was there Three Several times, One was very
remarkable about the latter End of September,
It was the Day that he had received an Answer
to his petition to Lord Chancellor as to the Appeal
for Murder; He had sent a Footman to have a
Copy of the Order, and the Footman brought Word
that the Clerk would bring it, and it was Examined
Word for Word before me, and the Keeper came up
Two or Three Several times to let him (Bambridge)
know that the time was come for people to go, —
Bambridge said that he had some particular
people with him, & if he shutt the Gates, he knew
what to do; Upon this we continued till after they
had Examined this Copy brought from Lord Chancellor
till ten o'clock & then I took my leave of him.

How many times did you Visit him? Three times.
Did yo go in the Habit of a Clergyman? No. What
was it you had on? It was a Grey Corded thing.
Had you a Hat with a Rose? I had a Hat without
a Rose. Had you Boots on? I beleived I had no
Boots on, I rid in Spatter Dashers which unbuttoned.
