Bambridge did pretend to me to be capable of great Discoveries and I went and acquainted Mr. Ogellthorpe about it, and the Man out of his great good Nature let Warbling and my self go back, but Bambridge trifled as he always did & we could gett nothing Material from him, there was a Door artfully left open (that our Conversation might be overheard) The Day before Bambridge had no Money but soon after he had a great Affluence which I believe must come from some body that see us there this amongst other things I putt in writing. I was told One Diverette who was come into Newgate for robbing on the Highway could make some Discoveries, At last Covertures was made to Warbling, I sayd It may be of Consequence, we will go and
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
