 for he is a very remarkable Man. When you had
 not the Key was it constantly in the Custody of
 Acker man? Yes. In the Months of April or May
 did any body attend besides you and your partner?
 No body but my self or him. Was you Turnkey all
 the time Bambridge was in Newgate? Yes.
 What other Door was it you spoke of? There is a sort
 of a Door that come out thro' a Room by Allen's House
 into the press yard. Had you the Key of that Door?
 No, Mr. Allen kept the Key of that Door. Who was
 Allen? He was Deputy Keeper of Newgate.
 Was there but one Door where you Turn the Key
 by the Cells? Only one by the Cells. And your partner
 and your self kept the Key? Yes. - What part of
 Newgate does the other Door open into? Into one
 of the Rooms in the press yard. Was that Door
 near to the Cells? No.
