Roger Johnson being called in to be confronted with Welland was again Examined

Johnson. — produce the Letter that you received from Campbell. I have no Letter nor ever had from Campbell. Did you ever receive a Letter from Campbell, and when? I never received a Letter from Campbell. Have you not in your pocket this Letter? I have several. If you have one from Campbell produce that? I have none. Have you ever a Letter signed J. C.? No.

Then the Witness took a Letter out of his pocket. Is that Campbell's Hand? No. Give up to the Clerk whatsoever Letters you have.

(The Committee did not think it proper to insist upon that so he did not produce them.)

Welland. — was shewn the Letter annexed to Johnson's Examination. — Was that the Letter you saw? No, the Letter I saw was about half a Sheet of paper. — Do you say this is the Roger Johnson you spoke of? Yes, he knows it. Did you see the Letter of Campbell to him? I saw it in his hand, and he gave it me to

read.
