Honour'd Sr,

As for the seizure of the lands in ffrencham the major and
 the rest doe performe their service out, and doe desire y^e shou
 may be our further proceedings or suit in law, but if it shou
 be charge to them, and be aspired they are willing to pay the same
 and the anns, and take it up; I may see both more understand
 your pleasure herein; we have little more here; only that an 600
 sold in ptawd in your mouth and 300 more are to be added to you;
 300 are ptawd here in Horw; the reason is, as it pretended the
 fear of an invasion by the Kinge of Scots, who as its sayd, is put away
 in flandrs and other the dominions of the Kinge of Spaine, Kinge
 of great Britan, and better from France doe testify the same;
 and y^e he hath gotten a considerable company of soldiers together;
 we have muche charge in worke the proceedings in ffrench, only they
 have passed some date notes against Charles Stuart, and against those
 which shall abett or assist him: Soe by my humble service out
