

Post them. The avant rear Guard and Pioneers as usual.
 Webb's Reg^t to March with the Train which Marches at the
 same time with the Army in 2 Columns. Gen^l Baggage in
 Heidelberg, at the Artillery at 4. Then follows it, that at Rhebach
 to fall in to their Rank as the Train passes, The Baggage of the
 Line to stay in the Camp, till orders from Dr. Mar^l General. The
 Baggage Horses to March with a serjeant at the head of their
 Regiment the Sick on the Flanks, or at the head of their Regiments
 with a serjeant who is to be broke if he goes from his Reg^t. All Horses
 and Carts belonging to the Elector of Mayance, to be immediately
 sent to Mr. Spotswood 2 Officers of a Reg^t to Ride of the Flanks to
 keep in Straglers and to be answerable for it. The Suttlers to take
 care not to go before otherwise they will certainly be plundered.

June 10th Brigad^r Ferguson, Maj^r Mordaunt. The Gen^l at 1/2 half
 Camp at hour after the Assembly and March immediately by the Left 2
 Tielhem Cap^t 100 with Officers in proportion at the Bread Waggon by
 3 in the Morning. Dr. Mar^l at 3 at the head of the Hessians. Gen^l
 Baggage follow the Artillery and that of the Line follow them
 The Guards as usual except those on the Flanks.

11th Brandford Brigad^r Hamilton, Major Cornwallis. Gen^l at 1/2 Assembly
 Camp at half hour after and March immediately by the left. The Dr. Mar^l
 Steensford at 3 at the bigg tree on the left of Webb's Reg^t Cap^t 2 Subs. & 60 half
 hour after two at the Train to make ways. Gen^l Baggage at
 the Rear of Churchills half hour after three, to follow of Train
 Baggage of the Line to stay till called for by the Conductors. The
 Hessian Regiment Marches with the Train, The Carts for the Sick
 to be kept till others come; Officers on the Flanks to hinder
 Meranders as usual. former Orders for Suttlers, Baggage Horses
 & Sick the same
