A Captain & 50 at the Mill on the right of the Highway; A Captain & 50 at the Red House between the Mill Guard & the Camp. A Major to command the whole, whose post is within the Town; to give Notice to all Guards where he may be found and in case of Alarm to repair to the Dukes Quarters. On the Market place none to go a meranding on pain of death.
