

150 with 2 Captains & Officers in proportion to be divided in 2 Troops to
 parkonille round the Camp. To Morrow at 4 in the Morning to assemble at
 the Rifle Grenadiers; to make their Report to the General of the day & to send
 to Mon^r Ivory for Guards to whom they are to be returned; At Ancha &
 Schranbenhausen the latter may be furnished with Beer, a Sargeant and
 12 of a Brigade will be given them for an Escort; Any who rob or plunder
 will be hanged without Mercy. There is now 3 Waggons to each
 Regiment, and One more to be delivered, the Commissary of the Bread will give
 half a Crown a Week and 2 pound of Bread per day to the Conductors of
 these Waggons, and when any of them is order'd to go for Bread there
 must be a Man with it with Arms to bring it back and a Sargeant of
 Brigade with them; they who neglect to send their Carts when order'd will
 want Bread, the Carts to be Tomorrow Morning at the Chapell, a Court
 Marshall at 8 at Mon^r Cyn^r Withers's who is President. The Orders
 about plundering to be proclaimed at the Head of each Regiment
