May 4th ... Marched from the Bosche to Maeselroy with the Breda Garrison. Forrage to be delivered by D^r Ma^r Armstrong.

5th Windsor. The Carts & Waggon to be discharged Gen^l at 5. Assembly at 1/2 hour after and to March at 6. The D^r Ma^r at Roffe's Dragoons at 4. The Gen^l Officers Baggage to March first, A Lap^t & 50 for the Front and another for the Rear Guard. no body to seize, Waggon excepted delivered by the D^r Ma^r Gen^l.

6th Venloe. The Gen^l at 5 Assembly half an hour after and to march at 6. The D^r Ma^r at Roffe's at 4 a weekly Return including Corporals but not Baggage Men

7th Aremmonde. Gen^l at 5 assembly half an hour after and to March at 6. the D^r Ma^r at Roffe's at 4. Guards as before

8th Maestricht. Gen^l at 5 assembly half an hour after and to March at 6 the D^r Ma^r at 4th foot Dragoons at 4. to March by the Right Guards as usual.

9th Liege No body to destroy or cut any corn, no body to stir out of Rom & Stalem the Camp

10th Maestricht. Gen^l at 4. Assembly half an hour after and March at 5. The Baggage to follow the Army, a rear Guard of 100 to be divided amongst the Baggage, 20 horses with the Baggage of the G^l Officers The present grand Guard at 3. with the D^r D^r at Roffe's Dragoons

N. B In our March a small Party of 2d Dragoons from Namur attacked our Baggage and carried off 22 horses out of D^r G. Lumley's Baggage but were pursued by a Squadron of Lord John Hayes's Dragoons who killed 5 and took 6. and likewise retook all the Horses

11th Liege The Gen^l at 6 assembly half an hour after & to March at 7 Macoyke The D^r M^rs at Roffe's at 5. 200 Men for the rear Guard commanded by a Major. The Gen^l Baggage at the head of the Train and the Train to follow the Army

12th Rechem Southampton. The Gen^l at 3 assembly 1/2 an hour after and to
