 Coblenz 31<sup>st</sup> to Castle am. June 1<sup>st</sup> at Berncastle staid till the 4<sup>th</sup>  
 and came to Treves and the 5<sup>th</sup> joined the Army

WB The Army in the mean time had marched and possessed it self of  
 the Plain between Sikes and Treves and encampd at Dist and  
 Cule.
