The Boors to receive Bread this Afternoon at 2 The Regiments to make as many Gabions as they can 3 Foot high and 2 feet 2 inches wide and to get the Attestations from their Commanding Officers how many they make and shall be paid 10 Shivers for each. not to Torrage any Horses but in the Field under an Escort of the Brigade to take off the Officers ordered to inspect the Boors at Work and put a Serjeant in every 300 Yards who if he does his Duty shall have 20 Shivers aday and otherwise, punished. The Pickets to stay in the Tents but to be very ready. Attestations to be given the Workers of Saucissions who shall be paid 8 Shivers aday by Mr Brockhausen appointed for that purpose to relieve the 300 between Mensin & Courtmay. No threshing of Corn on pain of Death nor Houses of Office to be made, an Officer of each Brigade to go round the Works and make a Report if the Serjeants have been diligent.
