Those Regiments who have people at Louvain are to send six Weeks pay to them. The Foot on the Dries side of the Difs to be under Arms at 8 in the Morning till they receive further Orders. Those on the other side to receive orders from My Lord Orkney. 200 Men with a Lieut. Colonel to be at the Church Yard of Hallewyn at 6 to morrow Morning to receive Orders from Major General Pallant. The Officers who believe they may have Deserters among the Garrison to be at 11 at the said Church Yard but must apply to Major General Pallant and not Seize any by force. The Garrison is to have 8 Covered Waggon which are not to be touched upon any pretence while the Garrison Marches through the Regiments under Arms, no body is to touch any Deserter. The Post at the Bridges port to be relieved at 7 in the Morning by a Colonel and 600 Men and at the same time The Trenches are to be relieved by Inf Prince, Tcharner, and Chambiere commanded by the Duke of Argyl who is likewise to Command the Posts in Town when the Garrison is marched out and may go in himself at 7 in the Morning to take an Account of
