N.B The Garrison marched out about 4000 men, they own they had near 1200 killed and wounded during the Siege & abundance of their Men Deserted in marching out. The Gouvernour was at the head of the Garrison, and Mons^r Caraman with the last Regim^t They all Saluted and Complimented the Duke who was there with the States and Mons^r Overkirk to see them March out we had lined the Chausſei for above half a Mile on each side with 15 Battalions of Foot Commanded by Lord Orkney & 10 Squadrons by Lieut Gen^r Sumley's some of their Covered Waggons broke but the Deserters in them were permitted to go off. The Duke of Argyl with a Detachment possessed the Town
