To Forrage to morrow according to the disposition appointed. The English at Wedeghen, none to stir out of Camp, none to destroy house whether inhabited or not: on pain of severe punishment. The Forragers at the head of their Regiments by 7 in the Morning a Lieutenant and 30 of each Regiment with them Communications to be made that a Squadron may pass in Front. The Lieutenant Colonels and Captains in the Guards to take their Rank and duty in the Army.

The out posts to be relieved as soon as the Bread is received and henceforth every 4 days to send to the Provost for all the Meranders and make them run the Gantlet 6 times through 300 Men. three Parties of 200 each and a Field Officer each of the Dutch Troops to be at 4 this Afternoon at Murray's Regiment, a Lieutenant Colonel & Major of the right Wing with 200 each to be at 4 at Orkney's Regiment. The Field Officers of the left to go at 3 and receive their Orders from General Salische & those of the right from General Lotterm.
