MB. In the Morning we had Accounts brought in that the Enemy
 were Marching towards Senefte upon which our Drums were
 ordered away with 1000 horse to mark the camp upon the heights
 above Nivelles and about 2 in the Afternoon the Army began to

 saw the left Wing of the Enemy's Camp at Senniff and their right
 towards the Chappel of Harlaimont and the head Dr^s at the castle
 of Vanderbeck, our Army encamped our Right near Argneene &
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
