Our Army Marched by the Right towards Sognies when the head was got as far as Marg, we had Accounts brought us That the Enemy was Marched over the Heath of bastian towards the plains of Cambion, our Army marched out of the Defiles between Courtenbois & Naast and got into the plains of Sognies where we encamped our left begining at Naast and our right extending between Canchre N Dame and Louvignies It rained from 11 last night & continued all this day most prodigiously which spoiled the ways and fatigued the Men so much that half the Army did not get up this Night nor none of the Artillery, We had Accounts that the Enemy are encamped, their Right near Chiores and their Left at Lens abundance of their Deserters come to us.
