NB The Enemy continuing in their Camp at Antoigne & waiting our Motion to pass the Scheld it was thought not adviseable to pass the Scheld at Helchim where we passed last Year, so the Army took their March passing a little below Alth & encamped the right at Bassebracle, and the left at Lessines where the Artillery and Baggage joined us
