12 Battalions and 1000 Grenadiers with my Lord Orkney, M. G. Webb, Brig^r Keppel, Nassau, Woudembourg and Boisset to be behind the Danish Brigade on the left at four this afternoon to leave their heavy Baggage behind them, to return all horses and Waggon belonging to the country because they are to be Employed in drawing the Cannon. There are 50 Squadrons under Count Tilly, St Genl Rantraw, Major General Rantraw & Bach with Six Brigadiers to March with the Foot and the whole to take orders from C. Tilly

NB. It was agreed on among the Generals and the States to bring the County of Artois under Contribution, to which intent a detachment of 50 Squadrons and 12 Battalions with 1000 Grenadiers was made this Afternoon with the following orders that the Horse under the Command of Count Tilly should March to Armentiers and from thence to La Bassée where they were to halt till the head of the Foot came up and so continue their March to the Plains between Lens and Arras and from thence to Detach a 1000 horse with all the Hussars into Picardy to ravage and put a consternation in the country, the foot under Command of my Lord Orkney to make good the Retreat of the Horse the whole Detachment was under the Direction of Count Tilly who had orders that in case the Duke of Berwick should show himself in the Plains to hinder the Execution of this project, to give him Battle
