At the firing of 5 pieces of Cannon all the Wheel Baggage to be loaded and sent to the Artillery, but the General not to beat till further Orders, when it beats to March in an hour after and when the 5 Guns fire the Generals of the Day are to go to my Lord Dukes for the Order of March, The Officers at Betighen to send 150 Men with the Bread Waggon that come from Audenarde to Kirkhoue and be at Kirkhoue to send as many with them to Avelghem where a Detachment of Horse will meet them (At twelve this night orders came from my Lord Orkney, M. Gen. Denhoff Brigadier Govan & Vertmuller with 2600 Foot and 400 without Arms for Work, A M. General and 1000 to Assemble immediately at Pont Espiere where they should receive orders from Maj. Gen. Cadogan this Detachment was not ordered till next night)

WB We had Advices that the Enemy were still at Ghent but were disposing every thing for a March.
